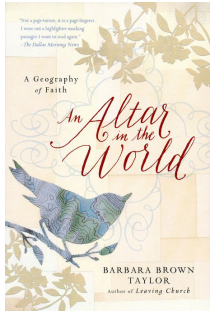


Currie Library Book Clubs • Selections for 2020-2021
