

Worship at the Ballpark Sunday, May 2, 10:30 am First National Bank Field 408 Bellemeade Street

ABOUT THE SERVICE: This will be our first in-person service with new Senior Pastor Jill Duffield! The Music Ministry as gone all out, with a bagpiper, brass quartet, music from the full Chancel Choir, and the Rejoice! and Chancel Choir ensembles. There will be a small gift reminding us that the Lord makes all things new! In case of inclimate weather, a decision will be made by 6 pm Saturday and notifications sent by email and text message as well as posted on the **home page** and social media.

WHEN SHOULD I ARRIVE? Gates open at 9:30 am. Allow for time to park, check in, and be seated.

WHERE CAN I PARK

- The lot on Bellemeade directly in front of the main gate (areas will be marked for those with disabilities) and in the deck just beyond this lot. 700-800 cars can park here.
- The side lot on North Edgeworth has space for 140 cars and also has a disability entrance.
- On the streets.

HOW DO I ENTER

- All three entrances, the Plaza Gate and the Bellemeade Gate on Bellemeade street, and the North Edgeworth gate, will be open.
- Masks are required for entry; extras will be available if you need one.
- Staff will check you in, and ushers will seat you following the ballpark's social-distancing plan.
- Offering baskets will be available at the entrances.
