We are collecting Hygiene Kits for Church World Service. they are distributed to disaster victims and people living in poverty. Please assemble the kit below and return to the Welcome Center by end of May.

We also would like to do some Cleanup Buckets. The list is on the back, and totals about \$75. If you would like to donate some items on the list, please drop them off and the committee will round out the collection.

## MM HYGIENE KITS LIST

When people are forced to abruptly leave their homes because of emergencies, they may not have time to pack the things they use on a daily basis like toothbrushes or soap. But after a few days without these items, they definitely miss them. Your hygiene kits offer a refreshing daily boost for someone when supplies are hard to come by. Please remember to send \$2/kit to CWS to cover the costs of processing.

## **SUPPLIES NEEDED:**

- ☐ One 1-gallon Ziploc bag
- ☐ One hand towel measuring 15"x28" to 16"x32" (No fingertip, bath, dish, or micro-fiber towels.)
- ☐ One washcloth
- ☐ One wide-tooth comb removed from the package (Found at discount dealers like **sallybeauty.com**. Search for wide tooth pastel comb to see example)
  - Must be sturdy with at least 6" of teeth
  - No pocket combs or picks
  - Rattail and combs without handles are acceptable
- ☐ One fingernail or toenail clipper (Either one is acceptable. Remove from packaging.)
- ☐ One bath-size bar of soap in the original package
- ☐ One toothbrush in the original package
- ☐ Ten standard size Band-Aids

All items must fit inside the Ziploc bag. Remove the excess air from the bag and seal before boxing. Do not add any extra items or toothpaste. A tube of extended expiration date toothpaste will be added to each hygiene kit just prior to its journey.



Hurricanes, floods and other disasters are happening more frequently. When our neighbors around the world experience these unforeseen circumstances, you can make the road to recovery easier with CWS Cleanup Buckets. These buckets are full of essential home recovery supplies that are needed after a disaster strikes. **NEW FOR 2023: CWS is requesting that you add an air freshener to each bucket. Several of the liquid items have updated ounce ranges to make it easier for you to find the cleaning supplies.** 

## **SUPPLIES NEEDED:**

- One 5-gallon bucket with resealable lid (If reused, please scrub clean. Do not use a bucket that has held chemicals of any kind. No screw lid. Advertisement on the outside acceptable.)
   NEW One 4-8 oz pump spray air freshener
   Five scouring pads (No stainless steel or pads with soap in them. Remove from packaging.)
   Seven sponges, including one large
   One scrub brush (With or without handle.)
   18 reusable, lightweight multipurpose dry cleaning towels (No terrycloth, microfiber or paper
- towels. Remove from packaging.)
- □ One 32-64 oz or two 25 oz bottle(s) of liquid laundry detergent
- ☐ One 16-34 oz bottle of liquid disinfectant dish soap
- ☐ One 12-40 oz bottle of liquid concentrate household cleaner that can be mixed with water (No spray bottles.)
- ☐ One package of 36-50 clothespins
- ☐ One 50-100 ft clothesline (Cotton or plastic line.)
- ☐ Five dust masks (N95 particulate respirator dust masks preferred; No surgical masks.)
- ☐ Two pairs of heavy-duty, waterproof dishwashing gloves (Latex-free, non-surgical. Durable for multiple-use. Remove from packaging.)
- ☐ One pair of work gloves (Cotton with leather palm or all leather.)
- □ 20-28 heavy duty or contractor type 30-45-gallon trash bags on a roll (Remove from packaging.)
- One 6-9 oz bottle of non-aerosol insect repellent (Pump spray bottles must have protective covers. Packs of 10-20 insect repellent wipes also acceptable.)

All cleaning items must be new and all liquid items must be capped and securely tightened. Place all items into the bucket, making sure they are packed securely to avoid damage during shipment. Snap the lid on tight and seal with packing tape.
